Shipboard Crisis Management for Masters and Chief Officers (3 days)	Covers Oil, Chemical, fire and SAR incidents using CMS and FMSS Simulators at ISC
Bridge Resource Management (5 days)	Modeled on IMO STCW Requirements (STCW Code B-VIII/2) with FMSS Simulation

Bridge Resource Management (4 days)	Modeled on IMO STCW Requirements (STCW Code B-VIII/2) with FMSS Simulation. A slightly compressed course
OOW Simulation Training Course (2 days)	Modeled on IMO STCW Requirements with FMSS simulation training
Bridge Team Management Simulation Course (3 days)	Modeled on IMO STCW requirements with FMSS simulation on ridge teaming especially for passage planning
Ship to Ship Transfer at Sea Simulation Training Course (4 days)	Covers attachment on board tankers during pilotage passage for officers from tankers (or if officers are from other ships, then respective ship types), classroom theory and simulation training at the ISC. This is the only course of its type in the world. Package with different course duration is also available.
Command Assessment Simulation Course (3 days)	Covers compressed BRM, psychometric test and stress test using FMSS.
Navigation Simulation Training in Critical Situations STICS (2 days)	Stress and Bridge team management principles applied.
ECDIS Simulation Training Course (STCW 11/1) 5 days	Modeled on IMO STCW requirements (STCW 11/1) with ECDIS and FMSS simulation.
Safe Navigation Watchkeeping Simulation Training Course (1 day)	Modeled on IMO STCW Requirements with FMSS simulation.
Radar Navigation Simulation Training Course (1 day)	Model on IMO STCW Requirements with FMSS and Radar Simulation.
Safe Navigation in Singapore & Malacca Straits (1 day)	Covers passage planning, case studies and FMSS exercises in Singapore and Malacca Straits.
